The Energy Assistance Program:

- Serves both renters and homeowners
- Provides help from \$300 to \$1,600 to pay for home heating, with an average benefit of about \$500
- Benefit amounts are based on the household's heating costs, household size and income.
- Helps with past due bills, energy disconnections, no/ low fuel in the tank & homeowners' furnace repairs
- Eligibility is based on the household's past 3 months of income, and assets are not counted
