## People's Energy Cooperative Trust – Operation Round Up® grants \$22,809 to local organizations

**ORONOCO, MN, January 24, 2022** — People's Energy Cooperative Operation Round Up® Trust Board provided \$22,809 in grants this quarter to the following area organizations:

- Bundles of Love Charity \$1,000 for bundles of supplies to mothers and infants in need
- Care Portal / Global Orphan Project \$2,500 to help vulnerable kids in Olmsted County
- Channel One, Inc. \$2,000 for their childhood hunger backpack program
- Childhood Cancer Community \$553 to help purchase supplies for 'Journey Packs'
- Hiawatha Homes Foundation \$1,000 to help purchase new furniture and appliances
- **High Forest Old Settlers Association** \$1,000 to help upgrade the electrical system at the picnic shelter
- **Kasson-Mantorville Community Education** \$500 in support of "What's Going On: Songs from the Vietnam War Era"

The People's Energy Cooperative Trust – Operation Round Up® fund started in 2002 and grants funds to a variety of charitable, educational, community, and youth-related programs and events.

The program is funded by donations made by members of People's Energy Cooperative who voluntarily have their monthly electric bill rounded up to the nearest dollar. Nearly 17,000 members currently participate with the average donation of \$6.00 a year per member, demonstrating that small change can add up to make a big difference.

Applications for funding are considered on a quarterly basis. The funds are held separately from the People's Energy Cooperative operating accounts and are administered through the Board of Trustees comprised of seven People's Energy Cooperative member volunteers.
